Our vision is to provide a high quality play based program where educators and families work collaboratively to provide learning opportunities that meet the needs of individual children.

## **5. Centre Facilities**

- Buildings and grounds  
The kindergarten has exceptionally high-grade acoustic treatment, to provide the best possible acoustic environment for children.  
A library provides space for small group or individual work, and for supervised book borrowing.  
The grounds are well shaded.  
Development of the outdoor area in recent years to incorporate a focus on nature and nature play. There is a large sandpit, watercourse with pump, swings, mud pit, climbing fort with slide, fairy garden, stick house, vegetable garden, lawn area and verandah.
- Capacity: 33 children per group
- Centre Ownership: Leased from Mitcham Council
- Access for children and staff with disabilities: There is wheelchair access to the building.
